

# Brass Monkey 2025 - 26

## Dates 29th June, 27th July, 31st August.

Rules : All club fishing rules apply, no more than 2 rods per angler, only 2 hooks per rod and all fish sizes and numbers etc . The angler or team with the heaviest BAG of fish on the day is crowned the winner.

There will be three (3) separate fish together called -

Singles : each angler fishes as an individual for the brass monkey trophy.

Doubles : Anglers will be randomly placed into teams of two before fishing starts.

Triples : Anglers will be randomly placed into teams of three after the weigh in.

We will all meet outside the Taradale Club Wharerangi Rd by 8.00 am sharp, at which time you will be told which beach and boundary that we all will fish, departing at 8.30am. The weigh in will be back at the Taradale Club, lines out of the water by 1.30pm, weigh in time is 2.00pm, Boundaries are two fold, any beach selected will fall within the clubs local boundary, Clifton in the south to Tongio in the north, the boundaries on the day will be announced on that morning. Any one who can't make it to the Taradale club on time can ring one of our organisers for the beach info .

The Brass Monkey series are first and foremost a fish together, a time for members to catch up over winter months, so come back to the club after fishing successfully or not, come share a bowl of hot chips and a drink.

To add a bit more fun there is a \$2.00 sweepstake for the heaviest FISH which is optional - winner takes all. So to all new members this is a great opportunity to meet up with the club and it's members, a bunch of like mind people who love to go fishing off the beach, they are more than happy to tell many stories, tips and tricks .Here's my first tip - it is called the Brass Monkey for reason WINTER cold, wet, so you will want to be prepared with plenty of good warm clothing. This might seem obvious to most but unless we have a good storm which makes the sea conditions too dangerous WE WILL FISH IT HEHEHE so set your alarms, take your hardened up pills and join us.
